We are really excited that the five weeks of the half term included a focus on exploring new partnerships for community learning and curriculum workshops. We are featuring these in the half term highlights newsletter, and look forward to sharing more on these plans at the end of the year.

Mencap Charity - Work Experience

The school is working with Mencap charity to increase the options for work experience placements. This is through funding from Camden Local Authority to promote more workplace experiences through the skills and preferences of our pupils.

This half term a new workplace experience in tech design was established at the Apple store on Regent's Street. Pupils from the Sixth Form classes are taking part in two visits for the work experience.

The first was a workshop to design an 'Emoji' where pupils used an individual iPad and Apple pencil to create an emoji image. The second session was a music tech session; using the Garage Band app to create and make music. The engagement in this new work environment was fantastic!



Open Orchestra

Open Orchestra is an inclusive ensemble with visiting musicians joining our school every Friday. The musicians work with three classes from the Ruby and Sapphire Pathway. The group music-making sessions support pupils to play an instrument with others. This term, pupils

have started to use the Clarion, an instrument that uses eye gaze technology to make music together.



London Inclusive Sports Academy

LISA is an inclusion sports provider who have begun to collaborate with pupils through physical activity in the community. We are starting a new partnership with LISA for community learning, and have trialled sessions. A set of LISA tennis sessions in Regent's Park and Trampolining at Talacre were very successful. The pupils

were supported by peer coaches in training. These sessions will continue into the second half of the term to explore more of their inclusive projects.



The Daily Mile

The 'Daily Mile' is a national health and wellbeing initiative, connecting schools across the country. Classes have started to participate in the 'Daily Mile' as a way to explore their local community while also supporting their healthy lifestyles.

We are also holding the 'Daily Mile' in the school to also promote healthy lifestyles through the known environments.

School Council

The Student Council met to share their preferences for community trips and visits for every pathway. Their ideas will inform the Summer Term community learning planning for classes.
